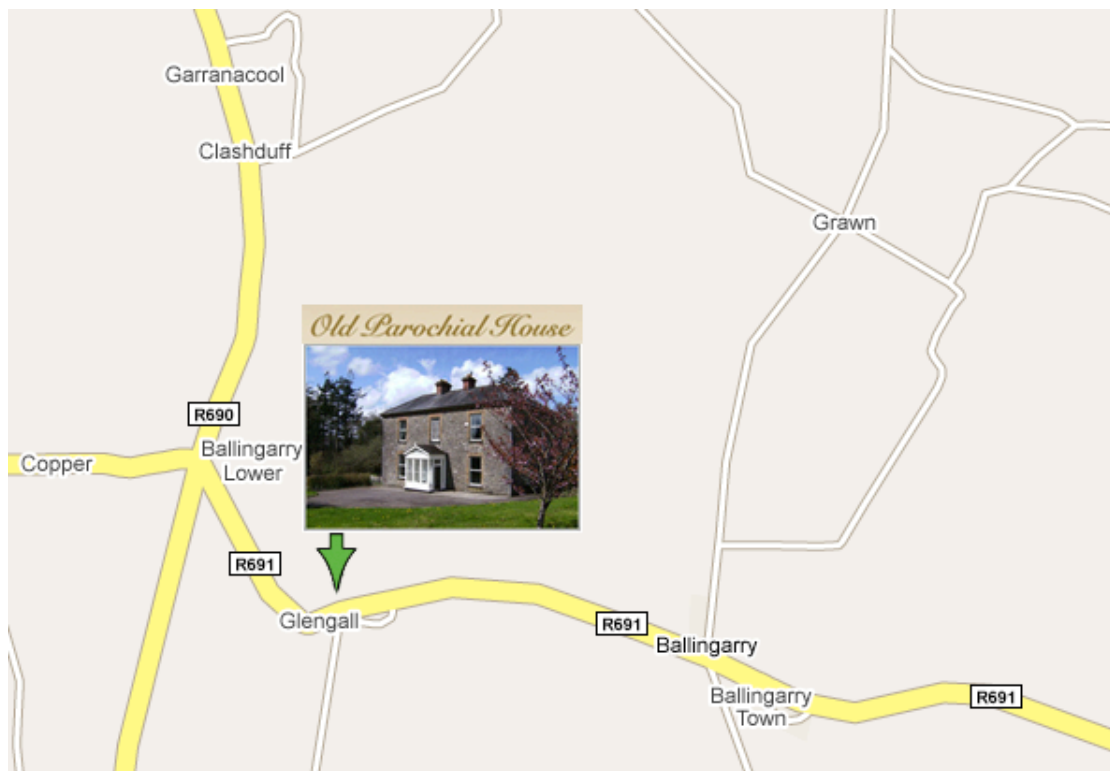




Located on the scenic route between Cashel and Kilkenny in County Tipperary, this beautiful period home was built in 1886 by request of his Grace Dr Croke, Archbishop of Cashel and Emly and served as the parish priest's house for the village of Ballingarry for over 100 years. In 2008 it was completely refurbished and transformed into a beautiful holiday residence. With accommodation for 11 guests the Old Parochial House offers visitors a truly unique experience in luxurious self-catering accommodation.

Whether you yearn for some quiet time away from it all or wish to explore the many attractions of this historic part of the country, the Old Parochial House is the perfect base for your holiday in Ireland. Relax and enjoy a book in the reading room, take some time out to listen to the flow of the river at the bottom of the garden, hike the famous Slievenamon enjoying spectacular views of the surrounding counties or just relax with a cup of tea in the drawing room. - the choice is yours!



How To Find Us

The Old Parochial house is approx. 10 miles from Urlingford which is located on the main Dublin / Cork road (N8).

Directions from Urlingford: Driving through Urlingford (from Dublin direction) turn left onto Togher Road (R389, signposted Killenaule). Continue on this road for approx. 3 miles. Turn left onto the R690 (signposted Mullinahone) and continue for approx 6 miles. At staggered crossroads turn left onto the R691. The Old Parochial House is located on the right 100m past the creamery.

The Local Area in Ballingarry.

- . The Old Parochial House, Ballingarry is located just 2 miles from the famous Famine Warehouse. During the great famine the Warehouse was the scene of the principal action of the 1848 Rebellion by the Young Irelanders. The house now exhibits the history of the Famine, mass emigration and the rebellion - admission is free.
- . Slievenamon, the most written about mountain in Ireland is just a 10 minute drive away from Old Parochial House in Ballingarry. It offers an easy climb to a spectacular 360° view of just about all of Tipperary, Kilkenny and Waterford.
- . A 20 minute drive from Old Parochial House Tipperary, takes you to Cashel, home of the Rock of Cashel the most visited Heritage site in Ireland, the Bolton Library which houses the smallest book in Ireland and some great restaurants.
- 0. The medieval city of Kilkenny is less than 25 minutes away by car from Old Parochial House, Tipperary. Here you can explore ancient laneways, visit the majestic halls of Kilkenny castle, take in some shopping or enjoy a great night out.
- 0. Thurles, the birthplace of Ireland's national sport hurling is 18 miles away. If you don't catch a game in Semple Stadium you might like to spend some time shopping or just enjoying a pint with the locals in one of its many pubs.
- 0. One of Ireland's finest golf courses is just 30 miles away at Mount Juliet, Thomastown. The Jack Nicklaus designed course is a challenging championship course and is presented in beautiful condition throughout the year.
